- theory and practical use of power tools and abrasive blasting equipment in the preparation of metal surfaces for coating applications;
- theory and practical use of spray painting equipment in the mixing and application of two-component paints including the principles of coating system;
- maintenance and repair procedures for airless spray; and
- safety aspects and practices in performing surface preparation and application of coating systems.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of instruction and training covers the following aspects:

- Explanation of Maintenance log and Manual
- Paint maintenance specification
- Safety precautions on painting and handling of paint materials
- Coating technology
- Quality control and quality control equipment
- Sandblasting and sandblasting equipments
- Surface preparation
- Vacuum blaster
- Practical use and servicing of airless spray paint equipment
- Practicum in the use of all equipments

METHOD: Combination of lecture-presentation, practical demonstration and guided hands-on practice on the proper use and handling of power tools, abrasive blasting equipment, spray painting equipment, and sandblasting machine.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Entry to this training is open to Boatswains, Able Seamen and deck ratings involved in carrying out normal maintenance work aboard ship.
