The one month activity was divided to three legs each having about 10 days stay on board T/S KFO .Engine/Deck watchkeeping, Practical Seamanship ,Ship / Bridge and Engine room duties, Safety and emergency drills and team building activities are the focus of the familiarization. Other activities like Mooring / Anchoring and Maneuvering familiarization, Engine / Bridge/ Gangway watch keeping duties and responsibilities, Lifeboat / Fire / Man overboard drills and Seamanship works are some of the activities on board.
