This Course is intended for Deck Officers and Prospective Deck Officers. It essentially covers the basic principles and practices to be observed in keeping a safe and efficient navigational watch in adherence to COLREG '72 and Regulation II/1 of STCW 1978 as amended.

COURSE AIMS: Upon completion of the course, participants should be able to gain thorough understanding on the requirement of the STCW 1978, Regulation II/1 (Basic Principles to be observed in keeping a Navigational Watch) especially on collision regulation and consequently practice and apply know-how in performing navigational watch in a simulated environment.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of instruction deals with the following subject and training areas:

- Watchkeeping Arrangement
- Fitness for Duty
- Navigational Equipment
- Navigational Duties and Responsibilities
- Navigation with Pilot Embark
- COLREG

METHOD: Combination of classroom lectures and practical instructions & training conducted on full mission bridge simulator.
